HOW TO REACH MANTUA (MANTOVA)

By air: Verona "Valerio Catullo" Airport, 25 km from Mantua.

The airport is well connected by daily flights with Rome, Paris, London, Frankfurt, Munich, Amsterdam. A public shuttle service is provided by A.P.T. buses (AEROBUS leaving the Airport to the Railway Station "Verona Porta Nuova". The service runs every 20 minutes and the trip is about 25 minutes long. Verona is connected with Mantua by regional trains (about 45 minutes trip).

By car: Highway A22 (Brennero-Modena), exit Mantua Nord (5 km from the city centre), two hours

driving from Milan or Venice (A4 and then A22).

By train: Mantua Railway Station (1 km from the congress venue), two-hour trip from Milan.
